Community Service

Reflecting the Signature commitment to community service, Signature students completed 9,700 hours of community service during the school year. Some typical community service activities included tutoring at Patchwork Central; volunteering at the Evansville Philharmonic office, Evansville Coalition for the Homeless, and Carver Community Center; helping with activities at Big Brothers/Big Sisters; assisting with American Red Cross blood drives; participating in benefits for Deaconess Hospital, Habitat for Humanity, and ARC; socializing and providing training to dogs at the Vanderburgh Humane Society to increase adoptability; and assisting with the efforts of Operation City Beautiful. Signature students also provided service to their school by helping to maintain the computer systems, performing repairs in the building, assisting with special events, and cleaning the Student Commons.
