

Meeting was called to order at 6:00PM on Wednesday, November 13th, 2019 by Signature PTSA Presidents Serena Laroia and Kim Wahl.

Attendance – A total of eight members were present.

Featured speaker Brad Niemeier told the group all about how he started Azzip Pizza and answered everyone's questions.

Secretary Report – Serena made a motion to approve the October minutes, Beth Hafele seconded. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer Report – Linda Sartore-McClain reviewed budget and actual spending through October. We currently have a balance of \$26,598.50 in our cash account as of the end of October. We did have a winner from the halfpot at Main Street Attraction. The total pot that we split with the winner was \$1,135.

Committee Reports

- Give Back Fundraisers:
 - Painting with a Twist: Saturday, November 16 (1-3PM): As of the meeting, only 3 people were signed up. Without five, the event would be cancelled (it was).
 - Azzip Pizza: Wednesday, December 11th (11AM-9:00PM), Green River location only.
- Teacher & Staff Holiday Luncheon: Tues., December 17th @YMCA (Chairperson needed): Jennifer Thread is taking care of decorations. There will be 6' rectangular tables. The group needs lots of help since there is no chairperson. There will be a sign-up genius link sent before. Suggestion was to send about 12 days before. We can take donations for paper goods, etc. and should consider requests for cash instead of gift cards for flexibility.
- Shop with Scrip: Nikki shared the gift card order form that will be distributed as well as the flyer of how to sign up for the program. LeAnn Freeman mentioned that she is able to use Scrip on amazon in combination with Smile. Ideally, gift cards will arrive the 2nd week of December.
- Fundraiser: RG Custom Engraving, Drinkware, etc.: An email went out today about it. Serena will follow up on shipping to school vs. shipping to home since her impression from the owner was that everything would be shipped to homes and not have to be sorted at school.
- Main Street Attraction: Summary, Silent Auction, Club Contest, Half Pot – Beth Hafele, LeAnn Freeman, Tracy McEuen, Kim Wahl: Beth shared feedback from the survey she conducted. There were comments about food safety that should probably be taken into account for next year. The opportunity to distribute a food safety pointers sheet to teachers to give all club members was discussed. Other items were discussed such as potentially addressing the placement of clubs with certain caveats (electricity needed, not conflicting with nearby booths) by placing them on a first come, first served basis. These will all be considerations of next year's committee. The event was a success. Tracy shared the winners of the booth contest. LeAnn shared the Silent Auction results and that some items were still be distributed to the highest bidders.
